What should I avoid with my new display?

Since all specimens in my displays are real, they are sensitive to environmental factors. All displays should not be placed in direct sunlight for extended periods of time, if they are kept in direct sunlight they can fade over time. They should also not be stored in humid environments, like bathrooms, or they could begin to grow mold. Finally if you are storing your display in a dark space (think drawers, storage boxes etc.), you should keep mothballs around to prevent attacks from pests. Use caution when handling mothballs however, as some contain strong chemicals!

How should I care for my new display?

Displays can be dusted gently and cleaned with glass cleaner. When cleaning with class cleaner however, spray a cloth and THEN wipe the display instead of spraying directly onto the glass. Spraying directly onto the glass could damage the contents of the display.

How should I care for my jewelry?

All jewelry is stainless steel unless stated otherwise. Most soaps are safe to use on stainless steel! I use a mild soap and water and then let it dry fully, but some people prefer to use dish soap and water. Isopropyl alcohol can also be used sparingly on stainless steel. I will sometimes use isopropyl after bringing new jewelry home to sanitize it as much as possible before wear. Do not leave jewelry in stagnant water for long periods of time. I have tested the jewelry by wearing it in the shower every day for weeks and have had no issue!
